Diffusion of ICT

PC penetration in the country (number of PCs/population) is estimated 21%; There are 81 access to internet each 100 persons.

Application of ICT to Public Administration

Only 8% of the employees in the Local Public Administration use a PC in his/hers workplace; also the percentage of civil servants with an internet access is very low (0,6%).

The governmental offices of the Central and the Local Public Administration can communicate each other through Intranet/Extranet networks.

Public Administration's visibility on line

36% of governmental bodies of Central PA has its own internet web site; the percentage decreases to 19% when referred to Local PA.

The legislative body, only, has its own internet web site.

Government's principal web sites generally include press release, speeches and statement of the Head of Government, official documents, government and legislative acts. Here, it is possible to send requests for information through e-mail.

There is also a specific portal for citizens.

E-government

Actually, through Internet, citizens and companies can just acquire information on Public Administration's activities. However, Government is now working to provide on-line services and an overall e-government strategy has been undertaken.
